Update on European Union Deforestation Regulation (EUDR)

On December 17, 2025, [the European Parliament formally adopted the agreed amendments to the EUDR](#), following the provisional political agreement reached earlier this month with the European Council. The revisions streamline implementation while preserving the regulation's fundamental objectives.

■ **Scope Update:** Printed materials – including books and newspapers – are no longer included in the regulation.

Although books are excluded from the EUDR, we are working to understand which products are defined as printed materials and the impact of the regulation on other wood-based products we produce or source for customers.

Lakeside Book remains focused on sustainability. We continue to prioritize responsible practices across our operations, as outlined in our [Sustainability Report](#). In addition, we are proud to offer publishers participation in the [PrintReleaf program](#), enabling them to engage in certified global reforestation projects to offset the equivalent volume of paper consumed in printing. Together, these initiatives ensure that every book we produce contributes to a more sustainable future.
